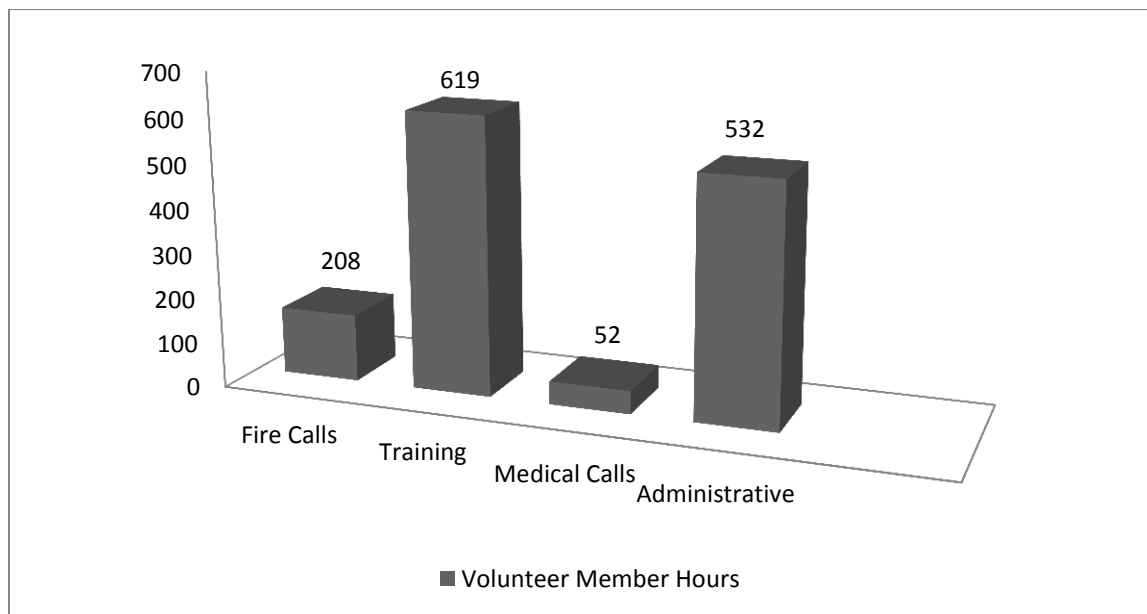

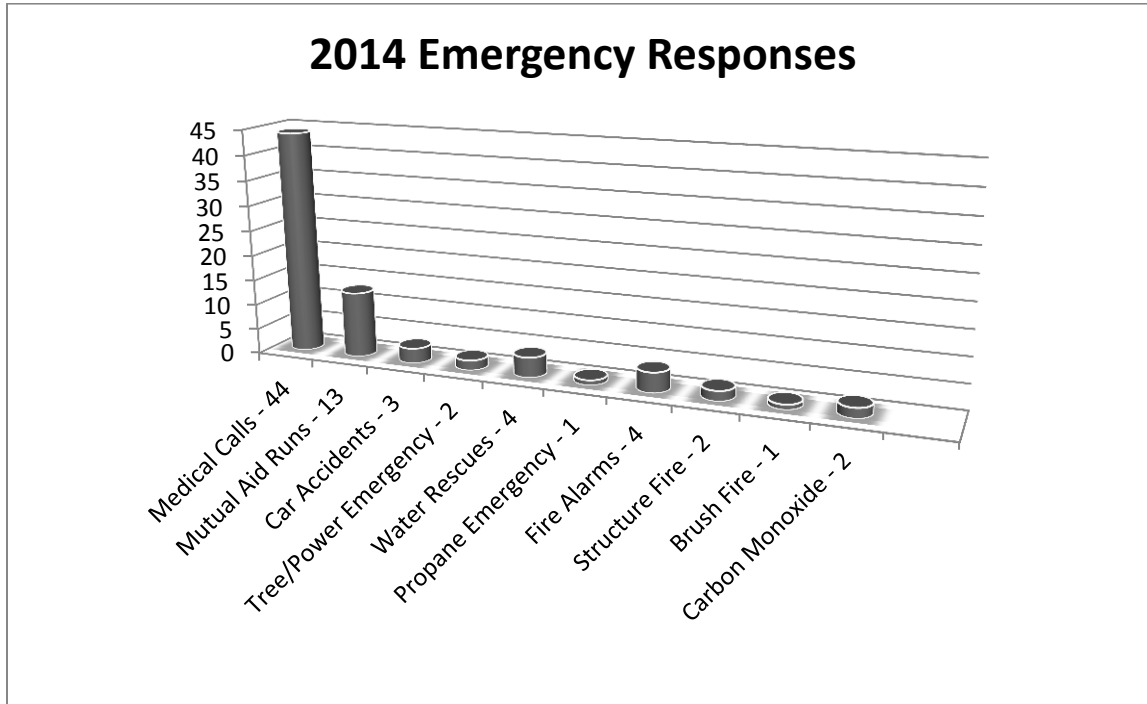
2014 ANNUAL REPORT

Our call volume once again decreased in 2014, but our medical calls increased by 15%. Along with answering calls for assistance, members also conducted fire inspections, performed fire prevention programs and participated in numerous training events. Department members had a total of 1,411 working hours for 2014.

The department takes great pride in the dedication our members show in their willingness to train. Department members spent 619 hours training in 2014. Training areas of focus were in the areas of pump operations, fire attack, self-preservation, victim search and removal, and boat operations. Four members of the department successfully completed Low Angle Rope Rescue Class this past fall. This class helped to prepare the department to rescue people below cliffs or on steep grades.



The department is constantly working to maintain our staffing levels which can be a challenge in small communities. In 2014 we added three firefighters to the department, two of them also being emergency medical responders.



The fire department would like to extend our deepest appreciation to the support that our taxpayers give us year after year. In 2015 we will continue to work to improve the services we provide to the town.
