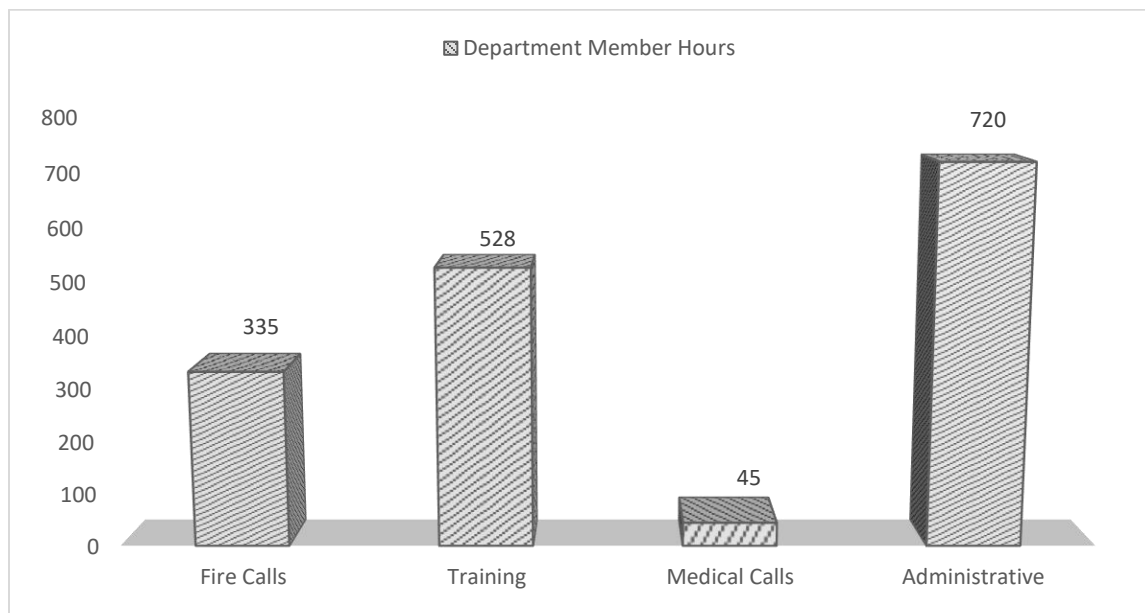

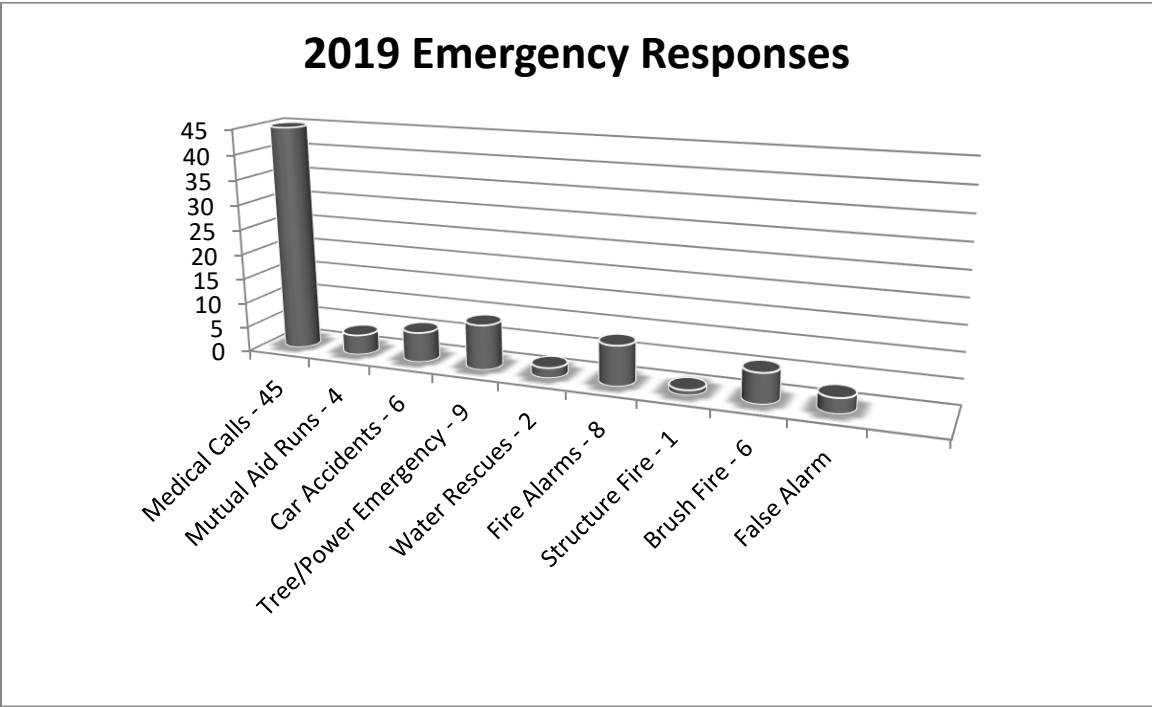
## 2019 ANNUAL REPORT

Answering emergency calls, performing fire prevention programs and participating in training events led to department members logging a total of 899 working hours for 2019.

The department takes great pride in the dedication our members show in their willingness to train. Department members spent 528 hours training in 2019. Training areas of focus were in pump operations, live fire attack, self-preservation, victim search and removal, driver training and boat operations.



The department is constantly working to maintain our staffing levels which can be a challenge in small communities. While the department has consistently had a full roster we find we are very thin with day time coverage. We are continuing our efforts at recruiting personnel that can help with day time response.



Call volume remained lower than average, however the workload to be prepared for emergency response remains the same. The department has continued to work hard to meet national, state and local standards in response and training.

The remodel of our town hall and fire station was completed in early 2019. The department members went above and beyond helping whenever needed to ensure the project went as smooth as possible. We are very happy with the new station and grateful to the taxpayers for funding the project.

The fire department would like to extend our deepest appreciation to the support that our taxpayers give us year after year.
