



Dear Town of Jacksonport electors,

The Town of Jacksonport has a strong history of good roads. The major part of our 47.5 miles are blacktop, and have been for several decades.

However, over the last 10-15 years we have been challenged to maintain the quality. Road costs have doubled, and our funding has held the same. It will take 80 years to replace all the miles of roads.

With much consideration, your board is requesting a \$200,000 increase in our tax levy. This will allow us to upgrade several miles of our worst roads beginning in 2022, and continue to maintain and upgrade all of our roads on a regular basis.

We are asking for your support on this at our budget hearing November 16, 2021 at 6 PM at the Town Hall. We will answer questions at that time, but welcome any questions to the board in the meantime. We would also invite you to take a drive on some of the following roads:
